The CGS manuscript collection, stretching 106 linear feet on the shelves, consists of loose papers, research and family histories donated to the CGS library over its 100-plus year history. This searchable database provides a synopsis of each collection, providing enough information to help you determine if further examination of a manuscript is beneficial to your own research. Individual collections may be viewed at the Library by appointment. Patrons may photograph (no flash), scan or copy documents, at the standard rate of 20 cents per page.
